Home Emergency Kit



Your Home Emergency Kit contents:

- Portable radio with spare batteries
- Torch with spare batteries
- First aid kit (with supplies necessary for your household)
- Candles and waterproof matches
- Important papers including emergency contact numbers
- Copy of any Home Emergency Plans (eg. Home FloodSafe Toolkit - available from the SES)
- Waterproof bag for valuables

If you have to evacuate, add to your Home Emergency Kit:

- A good supply of required medications
- Any special requirements for babies, the disabled, infirm and/or elderly
- Strong shoes
- · Fresh food and drinks

Your Home Emergency kit should be kept in a waterproof storage box.

Check your Home Emergency Kit contents regularly and restock any out-of-date items such as batteries.
