## People and Places Floods and Us in the Hawkesbury-Nepean Valley Stage 1 Geography Resources



### **Overview of Learning**

In the Stage 1 learning sequence students use inquiry skills and a variety of geographical tools to develop understanding of the features of places and the connections people have with places in the context of flooding in the Hawkesbury-Nepean Valley. At personal, local and regional scales, students investigate:

- · the properties of rainwater and flooding,
- the features of places affected by flooding,
- · the effects of flooding on access to places, and
- the ways in which the community should prepare for and respond to floods.

There are three learning sequences, each containing three or four teaching and learning activities that support Stage 1 geography syllabus outcomes.

#### **Geography K-10 Syllabus Outcomes**

- GE1-1 describes features of places and the connections people have with places
- GE1-3 communicates geographical information and uses geographical tools for inquiry
