The NSW State Emergency Service (NSW SES) is subject to the Privacy and Personal Information Protection Act 1998 (PPIP Act) in respect of your personal information collected by NSW SES. The NSW SES will collect and use (including personal information) (Information) provided by you as part of this survey will be used solely for the purpose of measuring and evaluating community resilience and engagement and for no other purpose (including marketing purposes).

If collected your Personal Information will only be disclosed in the following circumstances:

- Third parties where you consent to the use or disclosure; and
- Where required or authorised by law

Participating in this survey and the provision of personal information is voluntary.
