



Eugowra Town Bridge Gauge

Height at gauge	Expected consequence
14.02m	Probable Maximum Flood (PMF)* height.
11.02m	Peak height - 14 November 2022. Eugowra's 'Flood of Record' at 0.2% AEP**
10.38m	Estimated height of a 1% AEP flood event.
9.90m	Peak height - August 1990.
9.52m	Peak height - December 2010.
9.45m	Eugowra Town Siren is activated if water is expected to reach or exceed this height. Check the latest flood warning for Eugowra and move immediately to your closest Evacuation Centre, shown below, if it's safe: - Eugowra Showground – east Eugowra - Eugowra Public School – west Eugowra
9.00m	MAJOR FLOOD HEIGHT Approaches to the Eugowra Town Bridge can be impacted by floodwaters. The town can be cut in half at this point.
8.80m	The Escort Way may close at the lagoon (approx. 2km north-east of Eugowra).
8.70m	Eastern Eugowra community members at risk of flooding to relocate to Eugowra Showground using the safest route possible.
8.50m	West Eugowra community members at risk of flooding to consider relocating to the Eugowra Showground, if safe, before road access is lost.
8.00m	MINOR FLOOD HEIGHT

***Probable Maximum Flood (PMF)** is the largest flood that could conceivably be expected to occur at a particular location, usually estimated from probable maximum rainfall.

****Annual Exceedance Probability (AEP)** means the chance of a flood of a given or larger size occurring within the next 12 months, usually expressed as a percentage. Eugowra's 'Flood of Record' on the 14th November 2022 had an estimated AEP of 0.2%. This is a 1-in-500 chance of a flood of this size occurring in any one year.
